## ORDER

ORIGINAL. The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no passenger business has been transacted at applicant's station of Coso for more than two years, that there was no carload freight business and but one less-than-earload shipment received at

said station during this two-year period, and that continued mainte-

nance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Coso, County of Inyo, to retire a siding 2997.2 feet in length, located at said station, to climinate said name from its stations records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
