IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the above-named carriers be and they hereby are authorized to assess and collect for the transportation of rock, sand and gravel from Atascadero to points within a radius of fifty miles therefrom, rates not less than the rates provided in Appendix "A" to Decision No.

34084 of April 8, 1941 in this proceeding, and by this reference, made a part hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire on April 8, 1942.

The effective date of this order shall be five (5) days from the date hereof.
