O R D E R


It appears from the above numbered application that the parcel of property owned by Pacific Electric Railway Company, fronting on McGarry Street and extending from Eighth Street to Olympic Boulevard, in the City of Los Angeles, as described in paragraph III of said application, is no longer necessary for railroad purposes and that its disposition will not inconvenience the passenger or shipping public.



Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to dispose of said property by sale, substantially in accordance with the terms proposed in the application. Applicant is also authorized to abandon and remove two team tracks across said parcel of property, as shown in orange on map (C.E.H. 15540), attached to the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized. The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as the determination of the value of the property for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized. This authority

shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.
