OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Sacramento River Warehouse Company, a corporation, seeks authority to grant to the Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District, a public corporation, a right-of-way for the construction of a levee over lands in the Town of Princeton, Colusa County, upon which is situated a warehouse building. The Drainage District requires the right-of-way in order that it and other public agencies may complete the construction of a levee. A copy of the agreement specifying the terms under which the right-of-way is proposed to be granted to the Drainage District is on file in this proceeding.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Sacramento River Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to grant to the Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District, a public corporation, the right-of-way described in the application and to execute an agreement in the same form as the agreement on file in this proceeding.
