In the Matter of the Application of OVERLAND TERMINAL WAREHOUSE COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to engage in the warehouse business.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant is a public utility warehouseman occupying and operating 150,000 square feet of warehouse floor space in property located at Alameda Street and Olympic Boulevard (formerly Ninth and Alameda Streets) in the City of Los Angeles. These operations are conducted under a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 23343 (35 C.R.C. 771), in this proceeding and are, by the terms of that certificate, confined to the above described location. By supplemental application, applicant requests the elimination of this restriction. It represents that the granting of the supplemental application is necessary to permit transfer of a portion of the space operated to another location in the City of Los Angeles, and to permit transfers of space to other locations in that city which may become desirable.

Competing warehousemen have been notified of the proposed change in applicant's operating authority and have informed the Commission, in writing, that they have no objection to the proposal.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. No change is proposed in the amount of ware-

house space available for public storage. The supplemental application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 23343 of February 2, 1931, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by eliminating the restriction of the operating authority to Ninth and Alameda Streets (now Alameda Street and Olympic Boulevard).

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 23343 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof. -/
