In the Matter of the application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to abandon service and remove tracks and facilities on Bellevue Drive and Broadway in the City of Pasadena.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon service and remove its tracks on Bellevue Drive between Raymond Avenue and a connection with the tracks of Southern Pacific Company on Broadway at Evanston Place, in the City of Pasadena, as more particularly described in paragraph III of the application and as shown in yellow on the map (C.E. 10329), attached thereto.

Applicant is also authorized to remove the electrical overhead construction on Southern Pacific Company's track on Broadway northerly from Evanston Place to Green Street, and on a Southern Pacific spur track near Green Street.

Upon removal of the tracks as authorized herein, applicant shall repave the track area to the satisfaction of the City of Pasadena.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order. The effective

date of this order shall be the date hereof.
