FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application, Ira P. Lamb, a city and highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport grain, grain products and related commodities under contract with Sperry Flour Company at rates less than the established minimum rates. This authority is limited to defined areas in southern California. It will expire June 1, 1941. By supplemental application filed May 12, 1941, indefinite extension of the authority is sought. It is alleged that since the authority was granted applicant has experienced no material change in operating conditions and that operations under the authorized rates have been profitable.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that an extension of the authority is justified. Due, however, to the possibility that the conditions under which this service is rendered may change at any time the extension will be limited to a one-year period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Ira P. Lamb by Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application, be and it is here-
