ORDER APPROVING WHARF FRANCHISE

Applicant, by verified amended application, requests approval of an order of the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County, renewing a wharf franchise. Applicant alleges that it does not intend to operate as a public utility wharfinger, will not collect tolls, and will use the wharf solely for its own private commercial purposes.

Commission approval of the grant of such franchise is required by the Harbors and Navigation Code, Section 4000. It appearing that approval should be given, and that public hearing is not required, IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby accorded for the construction, operation and maintenance of a wharf on the southern shore of the Straits of Carquinez, in Contra Costa County, by Tide Water Associated Oil Company, as provided in the order of the Board of Supervisors of said County, dated May 5, 1941.
