Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on March 13, 1941, applied for authority to single-track that portion of its Whittier line between Slauson Junction and Walker, Los Angeles County, California. Applicant proposes to remove that portion of its outbound track as described in paragraph V of the application and as shown in yellow on the map (C.E. 10304), attached thereto.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, that the single track as proposed will not be adverse to public interest and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Theetric Railway Company is hereby authorized to single-track its Whittier line between Slauson Junction and Walker, in accordance with the plan described in the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof. The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not

exercised within one year from the date mereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
