BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Complaint of the CITY OF SEAL BEACH, a municipal corporation in the County of Orange, State of California, for a change of service and rates under the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to the Long Beach Motor Bus Company, a California corporation, to operate as a common carrier, a motor coach service for the transportation of persons and their hand baggage, as an extension of its existing line easterly in said City of Seal Beach, easterly along East Ocean Boulevard to Main Street, Seal Beach; thence northerly on Main Street to Central Avenue; thence easterly on Central Avenue to Tenth Street; thence northerly on Tenth Street to Electric Avenue; thence westerly on Electric Avenue to the end of the line at Main Street; returning southerly on Main Street to Ocean Boulevard, thence westerly on East Ocean Boulevard to Redondo Avenue, Long Beach.
