FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

San Jose City Lines, Inc., has made a request for modification of routing of its No. 3 Willow Glen line, as described in Decision No. 34194, dated May 13, 1941.

It appears that said modification of routing was contemplated at the time said decision was issued, but that one street, formerly known as Cherry Court, had not been cut through and improved; that this street is now open; and that the request should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the description of Line 3 - Willow Glen Line, as described in said Decision No. 34194, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

LINE 3 - WILLOW GLEN LINE:

Commencing at a loop around the blocks bounded by W. Santa Clara Street, Market Street, South First Street and West San Carlos Street; thence westerly on West San Carlos Street to Bird Avenue; thence on Bird Avenue to Coe Avenue; thence on Coe Avenue to Lincoln Avenue; thence on Minnesota Avenue; thence on Minnesota Avenue to Washington Avenue; thence on Washington Avenue to Glenwood Avenue to Cherry Avenue to Mercer Avenue (formerly Cherry Court); thence on Mercer Avenue to Hicks Avenue; thence on Hicks Avenue to Minnesota Avenue; thence on Minnesota Avenue; thence on Minnesota Avenue to Cherry Avenue; thence on Cherry Avenue to Willow Street to Lincoln Avenue.

In all other respects Decision No. 34194 shall remain in full force and effect.
