BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a spur track upon, along and across Alhambra Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade upon, along and across Alhambra Avenue, in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-483.65-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign. Applicant shall, within one hundred and eighty (180) days, submit a certified copy of a franchise or permit from the City of Los Angeles for the construction of said crossing at grade and, in the event that this is not done, the authorization herein granted for the installation of said crossing shall then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
