

Decision No. 25297

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of Asbury Rapid Transit System, a corporation, for authority to operate, as a temporary re-routing via the Southern Pacific Depot in Glendale, certain of its schedules now operating over its authorized and extended transportation common carrier service between the city of Pasadena on the one hand via Hollywood to Ocean Park on the other hand, via certain alternate routes.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

In the above entitled application, Asbury Rapid Transit System seeks the Commission's authority to operate, on a temporary six months' trial basis, via the Southern Pacific depot in Glendale, certain of its schedules now authorized between Pasadena and Arcadia, on the one hand, by way of Hollywood to Ocean Park, on the other hand.

Many organizations in the Cities of Pasadena and Hollywood have requested the establishment of such a service and, in addition, applicant has received numerous inquiries at its termini from individuals seeking service to the Southern Pacific depot in Glendale to and from Pasadena, Eagle Rock, Glendale and Hollywood. No change in schedules or fares is proposed.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Asbury Rapid Transit System may, as an alternative, in addition to its present route, operate its

busses on its Pasadena-Hollywood-Ocean Park division via Gardena Avenue, Central Avenue, Railroad Street, Cerritos Avenue, Gardena Avenue, Central Avenue and Gardena Avenue to Los Feliz Boulevard, in the City of Glendale.

The authority herein granted is subject to the condition that adequate service over the existing route shall be maintained and applicant shall, within fifteen (15) days, and on at least five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, file a time schedule, in triplicate, conforming to the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
