SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

A written request therefor having been received and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that conditions three (3) and four (4) appearing at sheet 6 of Decision No. 34238 are hereby amended to read as follows:

- "3. Applicant shall file and make effective within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, on not less than one (1) days' notice to the Railroad Commission and the public, time schedules covering the service herein authorized, in accordance with Exhibit 'B' attached to the application, and in a form satisfactory to the Commission.
- "4. Applicant shall file and make effective within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, on not less than one (1) days' notice to the Railroad Commission and the public, appropriate tariffs of passenger fares, rules and regulations, in accordance with Exhibit 'C' attached to the application, and in a form satisfactory to the Commission."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 34238 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.
