tinue service first be given to each of its water consumers at least forty-five (45) days prior to the day of actual discontinuance.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that California Water Service Company shall make refunds to its consumers within ten (10) days from the date of discontinuance of service of any amounts due on deposits made for main extensions or establishment of credit, and shall, within thirty (30) days after discontinuance of service to all said consumers, file with this Commission a verified statement that it has fully complied with the terms of this order.

This order shall be effective from the date hereof.
