OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing the execution of a deed of trust and the issue of a note by Thor Kofod.

The application shows that Thor Kofod is engaged in the public utility transportation business, by auto trucks, in the Delta region of the Sacramento and San Joaquin Valleys. On or about August 22, 1940 he executed a deed of trust and issued a note for \$9,186.65 to finance in part the reported cost of \$9,750.00 of a garage building and real estate used in his business. The note is payable in monthly installments of \$100, commencing one month after its date, including interest at the rate of 6% per annum. Up to December 31, 1940 the principal amount had been reduced to \$8,969.02.

Applicant did not obtain from this Commission an

effective when applicant has paid the minimum fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which minimum fee is Twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars.
