BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company dis-
 closes that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's
 station of Stanton during the past two years does not warrant the
 continued maintenance of said station as a Class "C" station.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is author-
 ized to change the classification of its non-agency station of
 Stanton, County of Orange, from Class "C" to Class "D," to remove
 a spur track at said station, and to amend its tariffs and time
 schedules accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Com-
 mission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the
 facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Com-
 mission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not
 exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall
 be effective immediately.
