## ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's station of Stanton during the past two years does not warrant the continued maintenance of said station as a Class "C" station.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of
Stanton, County of Orange, from Class "C" to Class "D," to remove
a spur track at said station, and to amend its tariffs and time
schedules accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
