ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed January 10, 1941, in the above entitled proceeding, United Parcel Service of Los Angeles, Inc., sought modification of rates established for the transportation of packages weighing 100 pounds or less, and modification of the charges established for the service of collecting and remitting monies in connection with C.O.D. shipments. The proposal relating to the package rates has been disposed of by Decision No. 33837 of January 23, 1941, and petitioner has requested that the proposal relating to the C.O.D. charges be dismissed.
