ORDER

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's non-agency station of Alto, Marin County, does not warrant its continued maintenance as a Class "C" station at which freight in carload lots, or in quantities not exceeding 5,000 pounds, will be received or delivered. Applicant requests authority to change the classification of such station to a Class "B" station at which freight in carload lots only will be received or delivered, and to remove the station buildings located at said station.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to change the classification of its non-agency station of Alto, Marin County, from Class "C" to Class "B," to remove the station buildings at said station, to change its station records, and to amend its tariffs accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after putting into effect the changes and abandonments authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
