O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railway has applied for authority to abandon several non-agency stations on its main line and on its Colusa and Woodland Branches. It appears that these non-agency stations have in the past been used almost exclusively for the meeting of passenger trains, the operation of which has now been discontinued. No freight traffic has been handled to or from said stations during the past year and the continued maintenance of the stations and the tracks is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Striplin, Stolp, Walton, Riviera, Summy, Sutter County, Marty, Vinn, Yolo County, Tuttle, Colusa County, and Lossee, Butte County; to abandon sidings located at said stations; to eliminate said names from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
