<u>ORDER</u>

In the above-numbered application Pacific Gas and Electric Company, which renders local passenger transportation service within the City of Sacramento, asks for authority to abandon street car service on its No. 3 Line (J Street Car Line), and substitute therefor motor coach service, and in addition requests authority to modify the route of its No. 1 Line (McKinley and Folsom Boulevard Bus Line).

It is the plan of the City of Secremento to make "J" Street into a boulevard, and the city is desirous of having the rails removed from this street and motor coach operation substituted for street cars.

It appears that the request is reasonable; that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary; and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gos and Electric Company is hereby authorized:

To abandon operation of its No. 3 Line (J-Street Car: Line) in the City of Sacramento, described as follows:
