O R D E R

In this application M. C. Yahne, Inc., requests permission to carry standing passengers on its buses operating between San Diego and Camp Elliott, and between San Bernardino-Riverside and Camp Haan.

Applicant alleges that a large number of military personnel is stationed at both Camp Elliott and Camp Haan and when this personnel is released on pay days or other occasions, it is not always possible to provide seats for all men who apply for transportation during these mass movements; also, that it would be an impractical operating practice to assign equipment permanently to these camps solely for the purpose of providing seats for all when the occasional mass movements occur.

It appears that the request is reasonable; that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary; and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant M. C. Yahne, Inc., is authorized to deviate from the provisions of Rule 2.08 of our General Order No. 93-A and to carry standing passengers on its buses between San Diego and Camp Elliott, and between San Bernardino-Riverside and Camp Haan, provided, however, that the major portion of the aisle headway is 6' 2" or more; that the number of standees in any passenger stage in said service does not exceed the number which could reasonably and safely be accommodated without crowding;

that each standee shall be supplied with a grab handle or other means of support; and that said standees shall not be permitted to occupy a position which will interfere with the view of the driver necessary for safe operation.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
