OPINION

By this joint amended application George E. Thomas and Joseph N. Caccamo have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by them to Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette of an operative right for the automotive transportation of passengers, as a passenger stage corporation, as such is defined in section 2% of the Public Utilities Act, between Redwood City, Canyon Sanitarium and Emerald Lake; and Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette have petitioned for authority to purchase and acquire said operating right and hereafter to operate thereunder, the sale and transfer to be in accordance with an agreement, a copy of which, marked Exhibit "A", is attached to the application and made a part thereof.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$1,000. Of this sum \$500 is alleged by the applicants to be the value of the equipment and \$500 to be the value of the intangibles.

The operating right herein proposed to be transferred was created by Decision No. 33864, dated February 4, 1941, on Application No. 23940. An amendment to the application shows that there has been a continuous daily operation under this certificate since its lawful inception pursuant to tariffs and time schedule on file with this Commission.

After full consideration of this matter the Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the public interest will be subserved by the granting of this application.

ORDER

It having been found as a fact that public convenience and necessity so require,

Caccamo are hereby authorized to transfer to Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette the passenger stage corporation operative right referred to in the foregoing opinion and Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette are hereby authorized to acquire said operative right and hereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that (1) George E. Thomas, Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette comply with Rule 9 of General Order No. 79 by filing in triplicate, within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, a withdrawal and adoption notice as required by said general order; and (2) that Joseph N. Caccamo and Emile J. Pouquette comply with Part IV of General Order No. 93-A within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than

five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
