BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct five crossings at grade of the State highway and one crossing at grade of city street with tracks of San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway in the City of Coronado, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application and shown on the prints attached thereto. Said crossings shall be identified as follows:

Crossing No. 36C-13.6, State highway,

Crossing No. 36C-13.9, State highway, replacing temporary crossing with same number authorized in Application No. 23508,

Crossing No. 14.2, State highway,

Crossing No. 14.4, State highway,

Crossing No. 14.5, State highway, replacing temporary crossing with same number authorized in Application No. 23508,

Crossing No. 36C-14.6-C, Glorieta Boulevard.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the construction plans and profiles attached to the application. Protection shall be by one Standard No.

1 crossing sign at each crossing (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
