## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 29786 of May 24, 1937, as amended, in this proceeding, J. A. Clark Draying Company, Ltd., a highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport specified iron and steel articles under contract with Columbia Steel Company at rates less than the established minimum rates. This authority was limited to points not more than twenty (20) miles distant by public highway from the steel company's Torrance plant. It expired May 9, 1941. By supplemental application filed July 7, 1941, reestablishment of the authority is sought. It is alleged that operating conditions have not changed materially since the original authority was granted, and that during its effectiveness rates charged thereunder returned a satisfactory profit.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental explication should be
granted. Due, however, to the possibility that the conditions under
which this service is rendered may change at any time the authority
will be limited to a one-year period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. A. Clark Draying Company, Ltd., be and it is hereby authorized to transport iron and steel articles as specified in Decision No. 29786 of May 24, 1937, in the above entitled application, under contract with Columbia Steel Company, at rates less than the established minimum rates but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix "A" of said Decision No. 29786.

This authority will expire one (1) year from the effective date of this order unless sooner changed, cancelled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
