BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a main track at grade across Taylor Street, Mission Street, Rosa Street, North 8th Street, and North 9th Street, in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application. Said crossing of Taylor Street shall be identified as a portion of Crossing No. DA-45.7. The other streets crossed are not now open to traffic and this order shall not be deemed as authority for such opening across said track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of the crossing with Taylor Street shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 wigwags (G. O. No. 75-B) installed in accordance with plans approved by the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
