BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Cedar, 8th, Shorey, Chase and New Streets and a side track at grade across 6th Street in Oakland, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Cedar and Shorey Streets as a portion of Crossing No. A-5.46-C,

6th Street as a portion of Crossing No. A-5.44-C,

Chase Street - unimproved,

New Street - unimproved.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at each numbered crossing.

This order is made upon the express condition that Chase and New Streets are not now actually constructed and open to travel at the respective points of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said streets to public use across said track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
