OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company reports in this application that it proposes to purchase, for \$86,065.00, seven 45-passenger, Model 798-6, gas driven motor coaches from the White Motor Company.

The company plans to purchase the motor coaches under a conditional sale contract which will provide for the payment by it of 1/84th of the purchase price monthly, commencing thirty days after delivery of the equipment, plus interest at the rate of four per cent per annum. It is proposed to execute but one contract for all the coaches to be acquired. Applicant reports that the terms of the contract, except for equipment listed therein, the amount due under the contract, and the time when such amount is payable, will be substantially the same as the contract filed in this proceeding on July 11, 1941.

It is reported that the seven coaches will be used on the company's new Brentwood line.

The Commission has considered this application and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary; that the


company should be authorized to execute a conditional sale contract to acquire the equipment to which reference is herein made; that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for through the execution of the contract is reasonably required for the purpose specified herein and that the expenditures for said purpose are not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to execute a conditional sale contract for the purpose of acquiring the seven coaches referred to herein, such contract to provide for the payment of \$86,065.00 in eighty-four monthly installments, commencing thirty days after delivery of the equipment, plus interest at the rate of four per cent per annum, said contract to be otherwise in substantially the same form as the contract filed in this proceeding on July 11, 1941, provided:

1. That the company shall file with the Commission a copy of such conditional sale contract within thirty (30) days after its execution, and

2. That the authority herein granted will become effective when applicant has paid the fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which fee is Eighty-seven (\$87.00) Dollars.
