## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 33104 of May 21, 1940 in this proceeding, Coast Line Truck Service, Inc., a highway contract carrier, was authorized to transport shark meat from San Francisco to Moss Landing under contract with California Packing Corporation for a rate less than the established minimum rate. This authority expired May 31, 1941. By supplemental application, filed July 14, 1941, reinstatement of the authority is sought. It is alleged that operating conditions have not changed materially since the original authority was granted, and that although some increase in operating expense may be experienced upon resumption of the handling of this traffic, the increase which may reasonably be anticipated will not be great enough to impair applicant's ability to perform the service on a compensatory basis under the authority sought.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted. Due, however, to the possibility that the conditions under which this service is to be rendered may change at any time the authority will be limited to a one-year period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Coast Line Truck Service, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to transport shark meat from San Francisco to Moss Landing under contract with California Packing Corporation for a rate less than the established minimum rate but not less than 15 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 30,000 pounds.

This authority shall expire one (1) year from the effective date of the order unless sooner changed, canceled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
