
SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER AND DENIAL OF REHEARING



Bekins Van Lines, Inc., having petitioned for a rehearing of Decision No. 34360, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the first sentence of the ordering paragraph on sheet 7 of said decision is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Linton L. Lowry authorizing the establishment and operation of an automotive service as a highway common carrier, as defined in section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of furniture as described under that heading in Western Classification No. 69, C.R.C.--W.C. No. 2 of R.C. Fyfe, Agent, except the packing requirement thereof; also household refrigerators, stoves, floor coverings, viz. linoleum, mats, matting or rugs, radio receiving sets, radio receiving sets and talking machines combined, children's vehicles, bicycles, sewing machines and household laundry machines, but only from, to or between the places of business of wholesalers, retailers, or jobbers, or for wholesalers, retailers or jobbers."

Rehearing of Decision No. 34360, as hereinabove amended, is denied.
