FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pasadena City Lines, Inc., in its supplemental applica-
 tion filed July 17, 1941, requests permission to modify the route
 of its Avenue 64 motor coach line as described in Decision No.
 33750, dated December 21, 1940, in order that service may be
 rendered to the territory south of California Street and adjacent
 to Los Robles Avenue.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public
 hearing is necessary and that the supplemental application should
 be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the description of the Avenue
 64 route, as shown in Decision No. 33750, dated December 21, 1940,
 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:


AVENUE 64 ROUTE:


From a loop (in Los Angeles) formed by Pasadena Avenue,
 Figueroa Street, Ruby Street, and Avenue 64; thence north
 on Avenue 64 and Melrose Avenue to Colorado Street; thence
 east on Colorado Street to Los Robles Avenue; thence south
 on Los Robles Avenue to Glenarm Street; thence west on
 Glenarm Street to Euclid Avenue; thence north on Euclid
 Avenue to Alpine Street; thence east on Alpine Street to
 Los Robles Avenue, and return over the same route to the
 point of beginning.


In all other respects Decision No. 33750 and amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.


The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
