## O R D E R

The Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County is authorized to construct a public highway at grade across the Parker Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Reilway Company near Cadiz, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be 2P-182.6identified as Crossing No. 2-287-6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shell bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than  $2l_{1}$  foot and grades of approach not greater than  $l_{1}$  per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Stendard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No: 2-297, B, about 1500 feet cast, shell be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after complotion pursuant to this order, applicant shell so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shell become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be offective immediately.
