In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across County Road known as Miramonte Avenue at Perry Station; a side track across County Road known as North Street at San Martin Station; and a side track across County Roads known as Masten Avenue and Lona Avenue, at Rucker Station, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to extend its passing track at Perry at grade across Wiramonte Avenue, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-66.9, and its passing track at San Martin at grade across North Street, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-74.4.

applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72 of a width to conform to the portion of the roads nor graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B) with circuits so arranged as to protect against movements in either direction on said passing tracks and the adjacent main line tracks.

The extension of these passing tracks is being undertaken in connection with the installation of centralized traffic control in this district which materially changes the method of operation of the existing passing tracks in that they become in effect second main line tracks and train movements may be expected in either direction at higher speeds than is now normally operated over these passing tracks. Therefore it appears desirable that not only the crossings herein authorized but also all existing crossings of roads and

streets with the existing portions of the passing tracks at Perry and San Martin and the existing passing track at Morgan Hill be protected in a similar manner. This authority is therefore granted on the express condition that the following crossings be protected as shown:

The ringing circuits for said signals shall be so arranged as to protect against train movements in either direction on either the main tracks or the passing tracks.

Applicant also requests authority to construct its passing track at Rucker across Lena Avenue, Crossing No. E-76.7, and Masten Avenue, Crossing No. E-76.9. Approach grades proposed by applicant at these two crossings or at the existing crossing with Rucker Avenue are not satisfactory and authority for these crossings is withheld pending modification of the application.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity of safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
