

Decision No. 33512

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC MOTOR TRUCKING COMPANY to ac-(1) quire, and LETHA B. SHAW, as Trustee, doing business under the firm name of American Stage Line, to sell, those certain operating or franchise rights for the transportation of passengers and property between Ferndale and Fernbridge, California, together with certain equipment pertaining thereto.

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

By the above-entitled joint application, as amended, (1) Clara F. Brice requests authority to sell and transfer an operative right and equipment for the transportation of passengers and property between Ferndale and Fernbridge to Pacific Motor Trucking Company.

Applicant Brice acquired the right under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 33981 (Application No. 24004.) Under the terms of the agreement of sele and transfer the consideration is shown to be two thousand seven hundred dollars.

An affidavit filed by applicant Brice shows that continuous service during the last two years has been provided between the points involved under the right proposed to be sold.

After due consideration the Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing in this matter is unnecessary and that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application.

Brice is hereby authorized to transfer to Pacific Motor Trucking Company the operative right and equipment referred to in the foregoing opinion, and Pacific Motor Trucking Company is hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said right and equipment and hereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall comply with the rules of General Orders Nos. 79 and 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing tariffs and time schedules in triplicate within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
