ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial side track at grade across County Road in the unincorporated town of Tipton, Tulare County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-259.9. Applicant shall beer the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by the two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion of said crossing applicant shall remove track shown in yellow upon the map attached to the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shell be effective immediately.
