ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across the main track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in the vicinity of Adeline Street, Oakland, Alameda County, California.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Said crossing shall be protected by a first-class interlocking plant in conformity with the provisions of our General Order No. 33-A

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. The authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
