O P I N I O N

Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, P. Brunetto and E. Tobacco have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by them to Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, R. Rossi and G. Iacopi of an operative right for the transportation of property <sup>(1)</sup> as a highway common carrier principally between certain points in and about the so-called Half Moon Bay Area in San Mateo County, on the one hand, and the San Francisco Bay Area points of San Francisco, Oakland, San Leandro and Emeryville, on the other hand; and Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, R. Rossi and G. Iacopi have petitioned for authority to purchase and acquire said operative right and hereafter operate thereunder. The sale and transfer is to be in accordance with an agreement, a copy of which, marked amended Exhibit "A," is attached to and made a part of the application.

(1) Limited, in part, to the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables, flowers, poultry and the return of empty containers therefor.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as \$4,666, of which \$4,566 represents the value of the equipment involved and \$100 represents the value of the operative right.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was created by Decision No. 27716, dated February 4, 1935 and Decision No. 32456, dated October 10, 1939, on Applications Nos. 19195 and 22378, respectively.

The application shows that daily service has been provided continuously for the past two years.

After full consideration of this matter the Commission is of the opinion that a public hearing is unnecessary and that the public interest will be subserved by the granting of the application.

#### O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, P. Brunetto and E. Tobacco are hereby authorized to transfer to Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, R. Rossi and G. Iacopi the operative right referred to in the foregoing opinion; and Ernest Del Cielo, G. Rossi, R. Rossi and G. Iacopi are hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said operative right and hereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants herein shall comply with the Commission's General Order No. 80 and with Part IV of the Commission's General Order No. 93-A by filing, in

triplicate, tariffs and time schedules as required by such rules within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this order and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
