DECISION NO. 34558

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across County Road known as Alessandro Road, in the County of San Bernardino, and across County Road known as Live Oak Canyon Road, in the County of Riverside, near the station of Ordway, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Alessandro Road in San Bernardino County and Live Oak Canyon Road in Riverside County at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. B-548.2 and B-549.5 respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to those portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways, and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent at Alessandro Road and 7 per cent at Live Oak Canyon Road. Protection at Crossing No. B-549.5 shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-B). Upon completion of the siding authorized herein and upon its being placed in service the existing side track crossing Live Oak Canyon Road, as shown in yellow on the map (Drawing D-1232) attached to the application shall be abandoned and removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
