ORDER VACATING ORDERS OF SUSPENSION  
AND INVESTIGATION




By order dated January 14, 1941, and orders supplemental thereto, the Commission suspended until October 10, 1941, the operation of Rules Nos. 19 and 19-A of Erikson Navigation Company's Local Freight Tariff No. 3-A, C.R.C. No. 5, providing a proposed allowance of 25 cents per 2,000 pounds on shipments of grain which are prepared by the consignor for bulk handling. The proposed allowance has now been canceled and the cause for suspension has thus been removed. The suspension orders will, therefore, be vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the orders of suspension and investigation in this proceeding be and they are hereby vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
