BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the County of Amador for permission to relocate crossing of public highway with railroad.) Application No. 24340

O R D E R

The County of Amador is authorized to construct County Road No. 65 across Ione Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Kings Station, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DG-133.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. DG-133.5, about 130 feet north, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
