ORDER

ORIGINAL

Pacific Electric Railway Company has requested authority to abandon its line of railroad along Cabrillo Avenue in the City of Torrance, Los Angeles County. The city has condemned the right of way on which this line is located and proposes to use it as a public street. Applicant owns tracks in Border Avenue, a parallel street, one block to the east, and such service as now operated over the tracks it proposes to abandon can be operated over the tracks in Border Avenue.

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its tracks from Cabrillo Avenue in the City of Torrance as described in the application and as shown on the print accompanying the application on one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the service and facilities authorized herein applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
