In the Matter of the Application of the CITY OF WHITTIER for permission to widen the grade crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad at the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Camilla Street, public streets in the City of Whittier.) Application No. 24360

O R D E R

ORIGINAL

The City of Whittier is authorized to widen the crossing at grade of Camilla Street across the Anaheim Branch of Union Pacific Railroad Company in Whittier, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 3Y-1.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be as shown on the print accompanying the application. Construction shall be equal to Standard No. 4 of G. O. No. 72.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
