ORDER

San Bernardino County is authorized to construct Meridian Avenue at grade across the main line of Southern Pacific Company near Colton, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-537.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall improve view conditions by removing two low sand hills from the southerly side of the crossing.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-537.5, about 140 feet south, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
