ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to sell certain property in the Town of Gardena, as described in the application and as shown in red on the print accompanying the application, for \$3,800 and to abandon and remove the spur track now serving said property.

Within thirty days after completion of the sale and removal of the tracks pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.
