O P I N I O N

In the above-entitled application, Henry F. Adams, W. Paul Butler and Albert C. Hamlin, doing business as A.B.E. Lines, have petitioned the Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer by them to Henry F. Adams, Russell E. Denney and Albert C. Hamlin of equipment and the passenger stage operative right for the transportation of passengers between Riverside and Camp Haan, and from and to points intermediate to Riverside and Camp Haan, as created by the Commission's Decisions Nos. 33824, 33858 and 34513. Henry F. Adams, Russell E. Denney and Albert C. Hamlin have petitioned for authority to purchase and acquire said equipment and operative right from said Adams, Butler and Hamlin and hereafter to operate thereunder. The sale and transfer is to be in accordance with an agreement, a copy of which marked Exhibit A is attached to the application and made a part thereof.

The consideration to be paid for the property proposed to be transferred is stated to be the sum of \$5,000, which, so it is asserted, represents the value of all the

interest of W. Paul Butler in and to said property.

After a full consideration of this matter the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request for the proposed transfer is in the public interest and that a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

Upon a full consideration of the above-entitled application and based upon the Commission's finding in the preceding opinion,

IT IS ORDERED that H. F. Adams and W. Paul Butler and Albert C. Hamlin are hereby authorized to transfer to H. F. Adams, Russell E. Denney and A. C. Hamlin the equipment and operative right referred to in the foregoing opinion; and H. F. Adams, Russell E. Denney and A. C. Hamlin are hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said equipment and operative right and hereafter to operate thereunder.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants herein shall comply with the Commission's General Order No. 79 and with Part IV of the Commission's General Order No. 93-A by filing in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
