O P I N I O N

This application is for authorization to dispose of certain real property in the City of Burbank, which property has been used and useful property in applicant's utility business and the Commission's authorization for its disposition is therefore required by the provisions of Section 51 of the Public Utilities Act.

The property involved is the office building within the City of Burbank, which applicant alleges has grown inadequate for its needs. A new site is being acquired for the construction of more adequate office facilities.

It is believed that applicant's request should be granted, and no public hearing upon the application is required.
