BY THE COMMISSION:


ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Broadway in Hawthorne, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Broadway is not now actually constructed and open to traffic at the point of crossing and this order is not an authorization for the construction of opening of said Broadway to public use across said track. Said track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding 3% will be feasible in the event that the construction of opening of Broadway across said track shall hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road travel.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one

year, (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
