BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company dis-
 closes that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at
 applicant's station of Mackert for more than two years and that con-
 tinued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is author-
 ized to abandon its non-agency station of Mackert, County of Sutter,
 to abandon and remove a siding approximately 1750 feet in length, to
 eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all
 tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than
 one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the fa-
 cilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commis-
 sion in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exer-
 cised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be
 effective immediately.
