BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a side track across an unnamed County Road and across Cedar Street in and in the vicinity of the City of Willows, County of Glenn, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Cedar Street and an unnamed county road at Willows, Glenn County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. AE-149.4 and AE-149.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each crossing (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
